Growing Well is dedicated to producing quality organic vegetables whilst building individuals' confidence and skills.



Growing Well is a wholly independent non-profit making company, an Industrial and Provident Society for the Benefit of the Community.

"Crop share" has been born from our hope to root our produce in the local community. This provides an opportunity for you to financially support the growing, our other activities and to eat fresh Cumbrian vegetables all year round.

We are a rural 2 hectare Soil Association certified organic site based on Low Sizergh Farm near Kendal. On our fields and in 4 productive polytunnels we produce a variety of seasonal vegetables in an environmentally sensitive way.



The scheme.

To join the crop share scheme you must become a member of Growing Well which involves an annual payment.



As a member of Growing Well you will be able to buy either a full weekly share (£15) or a half share of produce (£7.50).

As a shareholder you will receive a weekly update on what will be ready for the following week. Regular newsletters will provide added insight into the farming system that is producing your food. You will be invited to come and share, learn and grow on monthly workdays and to seasonal special events.

We will try to provide vegetables to the full value of your share each week. The amount of produce will vary from week to week. We will guarantee that over the season the full value of your share will be met.



When does it start?

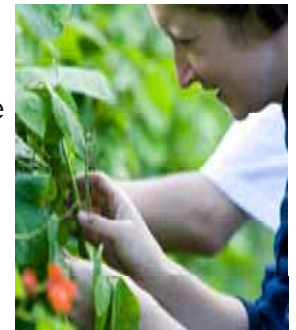
For the "crop share" to work we need your commitment. For 2009 we are piloting the scheme for six months. The first produce for share holders will be picked in June.



You can pay for your share either in full or by monthly instalments. There is a one month notice period.



To maximise the value of your share we must minimise distribution costs. At present we believe this can be done best by creating a network of local centralised drop off points managed by shareholders. This will depend on the help of local coordinators. There will be vegetable incentives for the coordinators.
